2. Who is responsible for protecting my information?

3. Why do you collect information about me?

We provide you with access to the Integre Trans logistics system. To do this, we need to collect, use and store information about you.

4. What information should I provide to you and why?

You do not need to provide anything to login into the logistic systems. In order to fulfil your contractual obligations, we provide you with a login name and password. You can change your password and login name, in which case you should provide us with a new login name and password.

5. What information do you collect about me from other sources?

We do not collect information about you from other sources.

6. What is the legal basis for collecting information about me?

We need your information so that we can provide access to the logistics system i.e. to implement our agreement and allow you to use the system (Article 6 (1) (b) of the General Data Protection Regulation);

7. Do you make automatic decisions? Are you profiling me?

You are not profiled; automatic decisions are not made.

8. Do you collect sensitive information about me?

Sensitive information about you is not collected.
